nformation for parent or guardian <u>:</u>
california law provides that after a child has been lawfully admitted to a kindergarten and has attended for a ear, the child shall be promoted to the first grade unless the school district and the child's parent/guardian gree to have the child continue attending kindergarten for not longer than one additional year. This rule opplies whether a child begins kindergarten at the beginning of a school year or at some later date, so that a hild who begins kindergarten in January, for example, shall be promoted the following January unless here is formal agreement to having him or her continue. Because kindergarten-age children often do not evelop at steady or predictable rates, the California Department of Education recommends that approval or a child to continue not be given until near the anniversary of a child's admittance to kindergarten. (may ot be more than one year beyond anniversary.)
