## Brief Explanation:

The Elementary/Middle School Pathway to Biliteracy Award is an award granted to students in Kindergarten, $5^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade certifying that they are in the process of achieving mastery of two or more languages. The Pathway Award is directly linked to the Language Learning Policy adopted by the San Diego Unified School District Board of Trustees in August of 2009, which recognizes that "in addition to being academically prepared and fully proficient in English, all students benefit from being proficient in another language". In addition, attainment of

the Pathway Award clearly advances tenets of the District's Vision 2020 and Global California 2030 for "preparing our students for the competitive global economy they will face in the years ahead" and the Vision 2020 goal to ensure that "students from all backgrounds in our district develop the ability to communicate in two languages." Qualifying students will receive the Elementary/Middle School Pathway to Biliteracy Award.
