CHAT PROGRAM

The trauma of childhood abuse can impact a child's overall wellness. The CHAT program offers trauma-specific therapy and advocacy services to address the effects of trauma.

We focus on a child's strengths and where they need support to improve coping strategies and create opportunities for healthy life choices.

ELIGIBILITY

- Under the age of 18
- Victim of or impacted by:
 - domestic violence
 - sexual abuse
 - emotional abuse
 - neglect

Regardless of immigration status

Regardless of involvement with Child Welfare Services

All Services available in English and Spanish at three business offices, and are *free of charge*.

THERAPY

Therapists create a safe trauma informed environment to:

- Improve coping strategies
- Improve decision-making and problem-solving
- Help develop skills to manage emotions and behavior
- Help develop healthy relationships
- Coordination with schools and other agencies

ADVOCACY

Advocate provides information and support for:

- Crisis Intervention
- Safety Planning
- Court Accompaniment
- VOC application assistance
- Monitoring academic progress
- Parent Education
- Referrals
